ConcepTests are thoughtful, multiple-choice or true-false questions, designed to assess and teach key concepts with minimal computation.

We expect to meet 6-8 times, for two hours at each meeting, in July and early August. We will begin by learning about ConcepTests and by looking at some examples from other disciplines.

Participating teachers will work on their own to create ConcepTests based on their middle school or high school geometry curriculum.

During the meetings we will share our work, discuss, and make edits.
